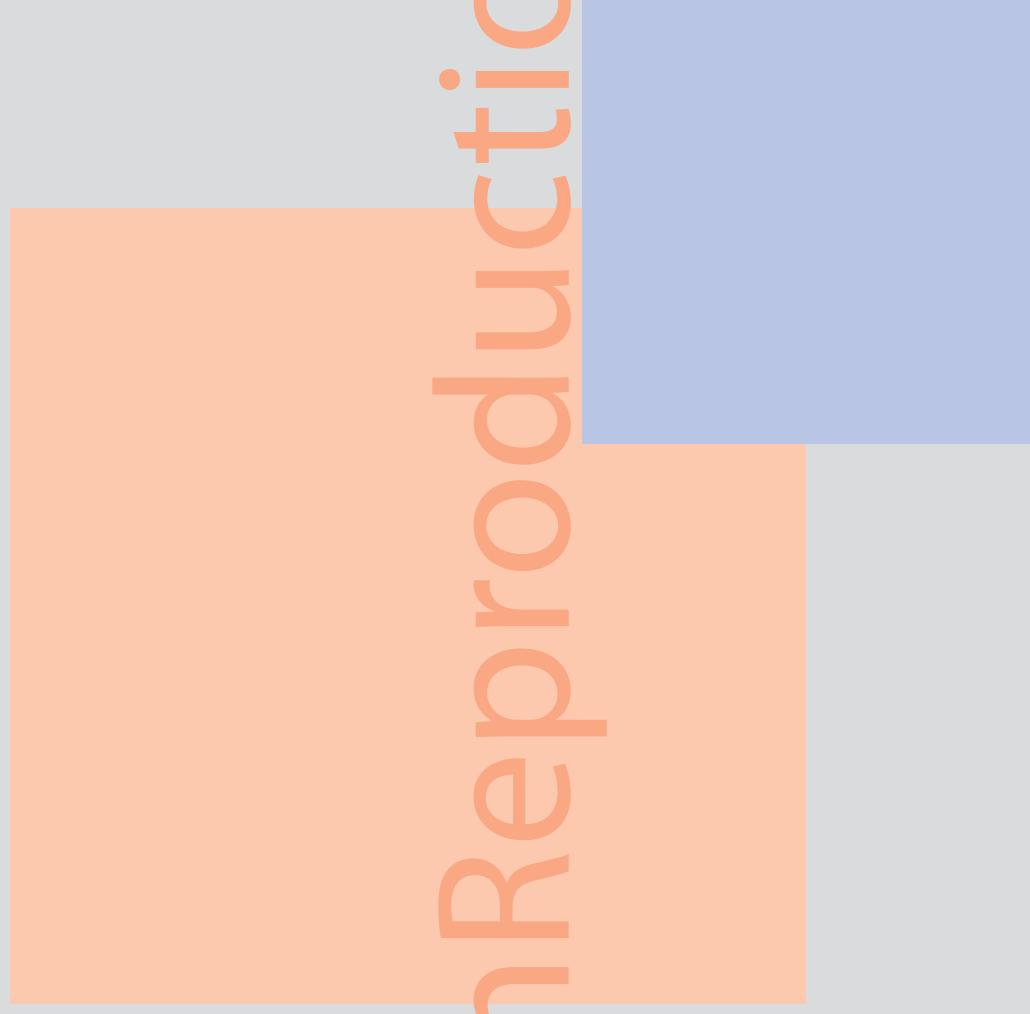

CONGRESS VENUE

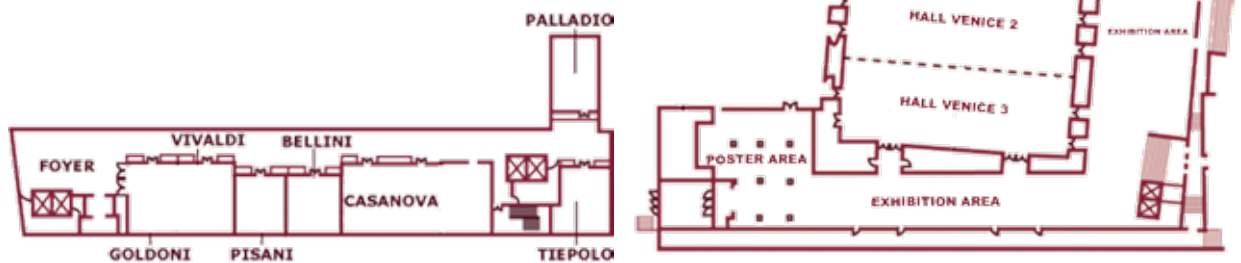
Hilton Molino Stucky, Venice is located on the island of Giudecca, just a few minutes by boat from Piazza San Marco and 10 km (40 minutes by boat) from Venice Marco Polo Airport.

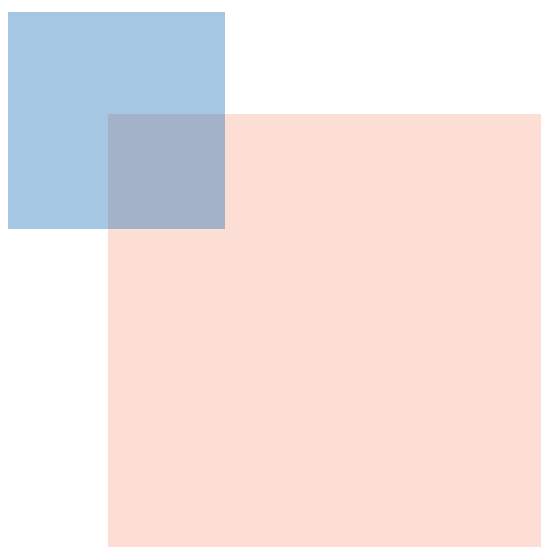

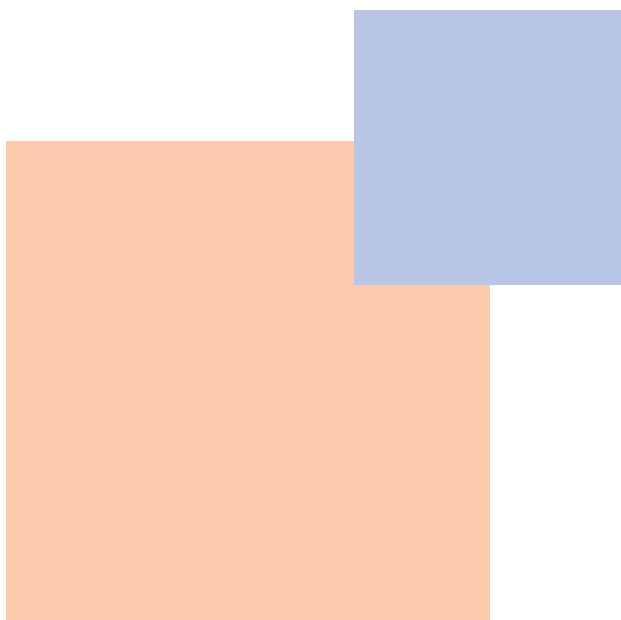

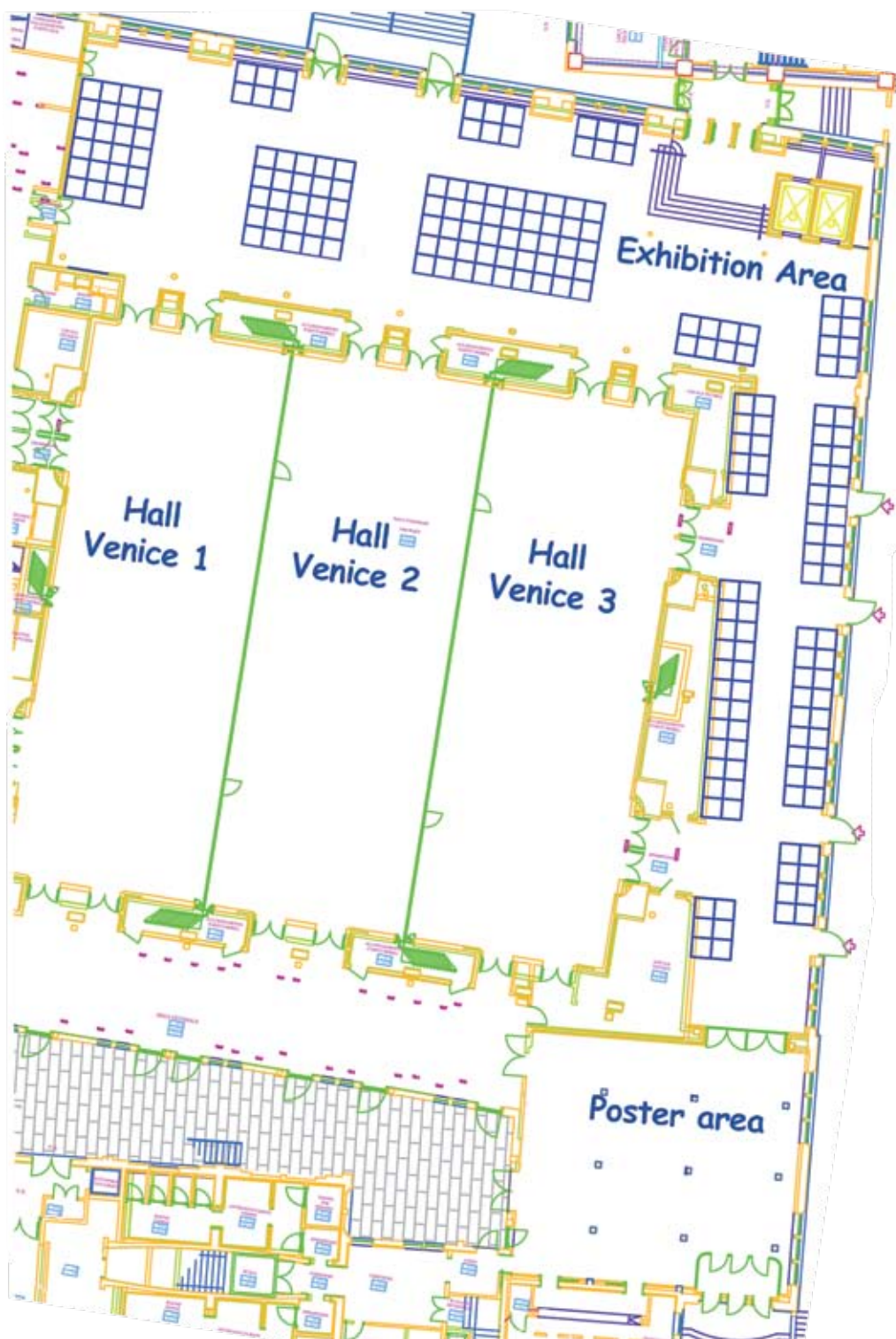

Cancellations should be requested in writing, sent by email, fax or post and receipt confirmed.

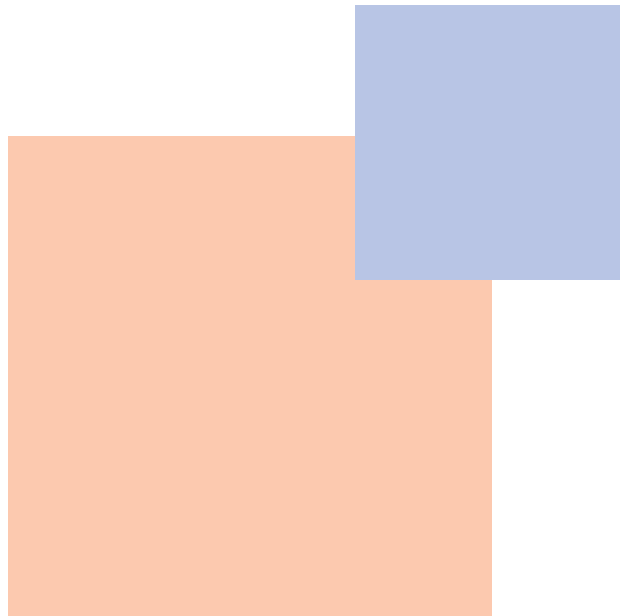
